RULES OF THE ROAD

Rehearsals are held on Saturdays starting at 9:00 a.m. at the School of Music in Room 170.
Rehearsals end promptly at 11:15 a.m.

Families may pay by check or cash. We cannot handle credit card payments. Make absolutely sure that you receive a receipt from the person handling the payment. Fees are due at the first rehearsal.

Attendance:

- a. Attendance will be taken at each rehearsal. Students who have a conflict with a school music activity will be excused. Family emergencies are also excusable.
- b. If a student is absent for more than **three rehearsals** for any reason, he/she will forfeit his/her membership in the group and will not be permitted to participate in the Concert at the end of the semester.
- c. Please provide a written note for all absences. Please notify Dr. Bayless in advance if possible. Absences without a valid note will be counted as unexcused.

Responsibilities:

- a. This is an HONOR band. Therefore, each student is responsible to practice his/her music and learn his/her parts to the best of his/her ability.
- b. At all rehearsals, all students are expected to provide their own pencils.
- c. Percussionists are expected to provide their own sticks and mallets.
- d. Participants are expected to take care of the music issued to them. You may mark your music in pencil, but **NEVER** in ink, pen or other marker.
- e. “To Be On Time Is To Be Late!” Please be at rehearsal and in your seat by 8:45 a.m., 15 minutes before the rehearsal begins, to warm-up quietly, tune with the strobe and mentally prepare yourself for rehearsal.

Parents:

- a. Please read this document over with your child so that there is a clear understanding of his/her responsibilities.
- b. If your child has a medical condition that the leaders should know about, please make us aware of the situation.
- c. All rehearsals are open to the public. We will be pleased if you would like to observe rehearsals.
